Purposes of Cub Scouting

Since 1930, the Boy Scouts of America has helped younger boys through Cub Scouting. It is a yearlong program designed to help boys grow in citizenship, character, and personal fitness. Cub Scouting strengthens family relationships through parent/guardian involvement in Cub Scout advancement and activities. The Cub Scout Motto is **DO YOUR BEST.**

Pack 152

Cub Scout Pack 152 is chartered through the Fremont Elks Lodge #2121 and is hosted at Weibel Elementary School. The pack consists of Cub Scout Dens. The pack and den leaders are all volunteers. Dens are segmented by grade level and meet at least once per month. On the third Thursday of the month, all dens and family members gather for a pack meeting at the Weibel Multi-purpose room.

Membership

Cub Scouting is for boys who are in the first grade through fifth grade, or between ages 6-10. A boy may become a Tiger Cub if he has completed Kindergarten and is age 6.

Advancement

The Cub Scout advancement plan provides fun for the boys, gives them a sense of personal achievement as they earn badges by learning new skills, and strengthens family understanding as adult family members work with boys on advancement projects.

The ranks are Tiger Cub (1st grade, age 6), Bobcat, Wolf (2nd, 7), Bear (3rd, 8), and Webelos (4th & 5th, ages 9-10).

Cost

The cost for the year is \$75. Cub Scouts is a year around program. Our fund-raisers include a Community Partners card from Albertson's and the recycling of inkjet cartridges.

Activities

Den meetings, Pack meetings, Pinewood Derby, Community Service projects, camping, swimming, archery, tours, hiking, fishing, skits, award ceremonies, Tiger Cub Pumpkin Patch, Kite Day, & Tiger Cub Safari, Boys' Life magazine, July 4th parade, Chess Tournament, Funfest, Cub Scout Games, etc.

Parent/Guardian Expectations

You are expected to be involved with Cub Scout activities. Badges earned are mostly certified by the parent/guardian. Parents are expected to attend den and pack meetings, volunteer for at least one major pack event, and are asked to serve on the Pack Committee.
