Webelos Woods

Pack 1559's Webelos Woods is an "entry level" outdoor camping experience focused on basic outdoor skills. Webelos attending this event will earn the Outdoorsman Activity badge and may complete significant portions of several other activity badges. Each Webelos Scout must be accompanied by his parent(s), or another adult (not a scout leader). Unfortunately, we will not have room for siblings. The cost will be approximately \$5.00 per person to cover food and campsite reservation.

What to Bring:

Camping Equipment

- Tent, poles, stakes
- Waterproof ground cloth
- Sleeping bag, pillow, pad

Clothes Bag

- Webelos Scout Uniform
- Poncho or Rain Gear
- Warm Jacket
- Pajamas or sweat suit
- 2pr Underwear
- Durable shoes, extra laces
- Hat or cap
- Gloves
- Extra socks, shoes

Toilet Kit

- Toothpaste, Toothbrush, comb
- Washcloth, Towel
- Soap in container

Personal Gear

- Mess Kit-Plate, Fork, Knife, Spoon,
- Water bottle
- Flashlight w/extra batteries, bulb
- Insect repellent
- Whistle
- Webelos Scout book

Extras

- Camera
- Work Gloves
- Fishing Gear

- Do not bring stoves or cooking items - these will be supplied by the Pack Leaders.
- Do not bring any electronics (radio, walkman, gameboy, etc.).
- Do not bring any weapons, alcoholic beverages, illegal drugs, tobacco products, fireworks, etc. (Commonsense will prevail - a Pack leader may ask you to remove any other dangerous or harmful items).
- Bring your own eating utensils (spoon and bowl/plate) and drinking cup.
- Bring a canteen or water bottle for the hike.
- Wear clothes appropriate to the weather.
- Be prepared to stay active outside in the rain.
(Wet blue jeans - or any cotton - can make you miserable and cold)
- Wear stout shoes appropriate to hiking on rocky and occasionally steep terrain.
- Bring a flashlight.

Rules

- Rules are based on the 12 points of the Scout Law: Trustworthy, Loyal, Helpful, Friendly Courteous, Kind, Obedient, Cheerful, Thrifty, Clean, Brave, and Reverent.
- Use the buddy system - especially outside (don't wander off from the camp site)
- Treat all adults as leaders - with respect
- Parents must **supervise** sunscreen/insect repellent/personal medication (inhalers/epi-pens).

Read Before Going

Responsibilities of Parents on a campout (Pages 455-456). Each Webelos Scout must be accompanied by his parent(s), or another adult (not a scout leader) to whom your parents have entrusted you. Unfortunately, we will not have room for siblings.

The Outdoor Code (pages 424-425)

Make your own sleeping bag (Page 400). Everyone must supply their own sleeping bags/blankets.

On this campout you can easily earn your **Outdoorsman Activity Badge** (Pages 394-412). You will be doing requirements 1 (Knots), 2 (Pitch a tent), 3(Webelos Overnight), 5 (Campfire), and 6 (Cook your own supper).

You will have a unique opportunity to finish requirements 5(Webelos overnight campout), requirement 3(earn Activity Badge from the Outdoor Group) and do requirement 2(Scout oath, law, badge, uniform, etc.) for the **Arrow of Light award** (Page 429).

Webelos working on the Webelos Badge can complete requirement 3 (Explain the Webelos Badge), requirement 4 (point out 3 special parts of the Webelos Scout Uniform), requirement 7 (understand Boy Scout Oath, Law, motto, slogan, salute, sign, and handclasp, and the Outdoor Code).
