REQUIREMENTS

Belt Loop

Complete these three requirements:

- ___ 1. Explain the rules of baseball to your leader or adult partner.
- ___ 2. Spend at least 30 minutes practicing baseball skills.
- ___ 3. Participate in a baseball game.

Sports Pin

Earn the Baseball belt loop, and complete five of the following requirements:

- ___ 4. Demonstrate correct pitching techniques.
- ___ 5. Demonstrate correct hitting techniques, including bunting.
- ___ 6. Explain the rules of base running. Explain base coaching signals.
- ___ 7. Demonstrate skill in the following sliding techniques: the straight-in slide, the hook slide, and the headfirst slide.
- ___ 8. Play five games of baseball using standard baseball rules.
- ___ 9. Draw a baseball field to scale or set one up for play.
- ___ 10. Attend a high school, college, or professional baseball game.
- ___ 11. Read a book about a baseball player and give a report about him or her to your den or family.
